The **Marching Grizzlies** had an outstanding competitive season, wrapping up their second and final competition on October 23rd. At both the Legacy of Champions in Carrollton on October 9th and the Okefenokee Sound of Gold Marching Championship in

Waycross, the Marching Grizzlies earned superior ratings in all categories, including drum majors, color guard, percussion, and band. At the Legacy of Champions, the band received Best in Class honors in all categories and were named the Silver Division Grand Champion, which included bands in the 1A, 2A, and 3A classifications. The color guard and percussion received the highest score, and the band received the second highest score out of all 17 competing bands. At the Okefenokee Sound of Gold Marching Championship, the band received the highest score in color guard, percussion, and woodwinds. They received the third highest drum major score, and the band received the fourth highest overall score of the day out of 18 competing bands!

ParentSquare

The district resumed sending weekly grade reports via ParentSquare October 23rd. ParentSquare uses the student contact information listed in Aspen. To update student information through [Express Gateway](#), follow the instructions found on the [Forms and Updates](#) page from CCSD's homepage.

As shared in [Barbara Jacoby's message from July 29th](#), in addition to receiving ParentSquare messages from your child's Principal by email, ParentSquare also offers a free app that you can download from your mobile phone's app store. The icon is a grey square with a colored dot at each corner. The app allows you to change your notification preferences to email, text and/or app messages; add additional contact information; and change language preferences. It also allows you to decide if you want these messages instantly, as soon as they are sent, or if you prefer the digest feature, which allows you to receive all messages together later in the day. Please be advised that if you turn off receiving messages through ParentSquare, you will not receive timely important messages from your child's Principal.
