Consolidated School Improvement Plan 2017-18 - Review

- Goal 1: Student in third through fifth grade will increase their performance in ELA on GA Milestones from 47% Proficient or Distinguished to 62% Proficient or Distinguished by SY 2019. **Met 58% - 2017**
- Goal 2: Student in third through fifth grade will increase their performance in Math on GA Milestones from 53% Proficient or Distinguished to 65% Proficient or Distinguished by SY 2019. **Met 62% - 2017**

CCRPI for 2017 Changes for CCRPI 2018



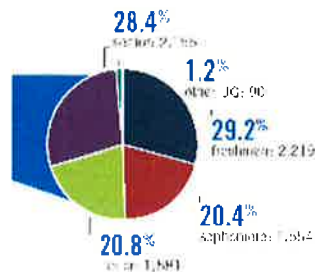

Reviewed Consolidated School Improvement Plan 2018-2018

Met goals for 2017 in ELA and Math

Reviewed data from CCRPI comparisons to like CCSD schools, all CCSD schools, and GA schools.

Reviewed Milestones scores from 2015-2017 including looking at subgroups and explaining how these are calculated. Looked at growth chart for subgroups from 2015-2017

Looked at Governor's Office of Student Achievement website and how to access this site and Carmel's information. (Paula will send out link to members).

Discussed changes made this year and how this may affect scores. Changes included changing standards in Science and Social Studies, ELA changes at the district level, and the state department changing measures (baseline is now from 2017). Also discussed how population group size for subgroups is changing from 40 to 15 which means smaller populations will now be represented and receive scores.

CCRPI – we will be better able to figure out our score with staff by using models.

Other changes to CCRPI:

EL performance is measured by movement from one performance band to another on ACCESS.

Progress toward EL proficiency will be 10% of the weight.

ELA and Math will receive 90% of weight (split equally)

Attendance – students absent less than 10% of enrolled days with minimum enrollment of 30 days

Lexile Midpoint – students demonstrating reading comprehension at or above midpoint of Lexile band

Reviewed multicultural arts week calendar.

Discussed 5 year enrollment forecast

Surveys – upcoming survey will be for parents of SPED students.

Questions/Comments from group:

Mr. Powell - commented that Ms. Willis is a rockstar. She's done a great job with computer club.

Mr. Powell asked about the upcoming school days during February break. He was wondering how many students might be out. Ms. Crumbley indicated that we should not have many more out than we do right now with illnesses and such. Regular instruction will continue with some grade levels doing specialized activities such as 3rd grade doing a Math rotation day among classes.
