- **Approval of Agenda**- the agenda was initially sent to the school council on 11/10/21 for initial review. Nicole Vaught made a motion to approve the agenda for the 11/11/21 meeting as distributed and Ali Toole 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and the motion received unanimous approval.
- **Report of the Principal**
  - **Campus updates-**
    - School board visit- the school board was able to visit the school for the first time since the beginning of the pandemic. They were able to see the Z-space lab, media center, new wings/construction of the school and see some of the amazing things our kids are doing.
    - TVs with announcements are up and running in the rotunda and cafeteria
    - Math 360 Classrooms- Principal Bryller is working on grants to be able to transform our math classrooms to “Math 360” classrooms
    - Smart Panels -The county has approved the purchase of smart panels for all of the academic classrooms similar to those in our new wings (this will begin with elementary schools first)
    - A tablet for each instructional classroom has been ordered- Bluetooth capable to allow for the teachers and students to interact with the smart panel from anywhere in the classroom
    - Positive behavior system- will begin Monday, November 15<sup>th</sup> – we will be reinforcing positive behaviors and transitioning to a ticket economy as well as having end of quarter celebrations
    - Honor roll and Merit roll bag tags went out for quarter 1 with the help of our PTSA - students were excited and are working toward earning one in quarter 2
    - National Jr Honor Society inductions will take place on 11/11/21
    - Drama department is working on a school play
    - Principal Bryller is continuing campus improvements
  - **Q2 scheduling**
    - Digital learning day on November 19<sup>th</sup>
    - December 1st is the spelling bee
    - Mid-terms will be December 15-17
    - December 17<sup>th</sup> is a half day for middle and high schools
- **New Business**
